What can you do with an ETA

Your ETA allows you to travel to the UK for 6 months for:

- tourism
- visiting family or friends
- business
- short-term study (courses up to 6 months)
- paid permitted engagement (you must do the engagement in the first 30 days of your visit)

You can also use an ETA to:

- transit through the UK
- come to the UK for up to 3 months as a creative worker

To come to the UK for any other reason, you will need to apply for a visa.
